

Port of Workington Annual Performance Review Summary 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023

The Duty Holder together with Workington Harbour Management Committee (WHMC) recognise they have a responsibility under the Port Marine Safety Code (PMSC) to publicly report on the performance of the Port against its Safety Plan for Marine Operations.

The annual report (April 2022 to March 2023) showed that the objectives and key performance indicators set out in the Marine Safety Management 3-year plan (2019 – 2022) for marine compliance, identified a high level of compliance considering the impact of COVID 19 had upon the UK and the Port functioning.

Therefore, demonstrating that the Port of Workington's marine compliance meets the standard laid down in the Port's Marine Safety Management System and that of the Port Marine Safety Code (PMSC) 2016.

In conclusion the Director for Resources as Duty Holder for the Statutory Harbour Authority, is satisfied with the findings and corrective action that has been identified and taken, to ensure the Port fully complies with the requirements of the PMSC.
